Minai participated in FSA FLEX program in 1995-96. She attended Hemet High School in Hemet, California. Upon her return from US, she enrolled in University of Business and Public Administration (Russia), where she majored in Finance and Credit.

Minai has a diversity of work experiences. Since 1996 she worked as Projects Coordinator at the US-Azerbaijan Chamber of Commerce in Washington DC, provided logistical support to the “Development of Tourism in Azerbaijan” team under the Ministry of Youth, Sport and Tourism and concentrated in Sales and Marketing in the hospitality industry.
